Treasurer's Report: Mara reported that in addition to our prudent reserve of \$3,500, our operating account totals \$5,011(all figures are rounded off). Our income from 7th Tradition, both individual and group, was \$703. We paid \$311 for Kerry's hotel stay at the Region 5 (R5) Spring Assembly held March 7th to 9th and \$1,713 to reserve our place for TPI's 2026 retreat in planning now. Mara will be sending \$630 to the World Service Office (WSO) this month. (Correct, Mara?

Region 5 Spring Assembly Report: Kerry reported that R5 will hold assemblies twice a year, with the Fall's in person and the Spring's virtually, hoping the virtual assembly will encourage greater service through attendance. There is a new address for R5 7th Tradition donations: Region 5 of OA, P.O. Box 22175, Louisville, KY 40252. Please remind those donating to include the meeting or service body ID numbers. Also, the WSO suggests that the distribution of donations to Intergroups, WSO and Regions change from 60-30-10 to 50-40-10, respectively.

Literature purchases continue to decline so the World Service Business Office asks we purchase through it rather than Amazon. Also, the Board of Trustees asks that we discourage minors from
